ON-ICE PROGRAMS OFFERED FOR THE 2010-2011 SEASON

COMPETITIVE (COMP.)

For single skaters who have passed a Competitive Test or Senior Silver Free Test. Skaters are offered a well-balanced program of freeskate, edge/turn, stroking and spins. *No dance/pairs skating allowed on the Competitive Sessions. Off ice included.*

TEST 3 (T3)

This program is designed primarily for the Test Skater. All skaters must have passed **2 complete** Senior Bronze Tests – For example **any 2 of a complete** Freeskate, Skills or Dance tests or higher or must be 16 years of age or older and have a private coach. Skaters are offered a well-balanced program of freeskate, dance, skills, stroking and spins. *Off ice included.*

TEST 2 (T2)

This program is designed for the Test Skater. All skaters must have passed **2 complete** Preliminary Tests – For example **any 2 of a complete** Freeskate, Skills or Dance tests and have a private coach. Skaters are offered a well-balanced program of freeskate, dance, skills, and stroking. *Off ice included.*

TEST 1 (T1)

This program is designed primarily for the Test Skater. All skaters must have passed Stage 6 of the CanSkate program and can do a Waltz jump, Salchow and Toe Loop, and must have a private coach. Skaters are offered a well-balanced program of freeskate, dance, skills, and stroking. *Off ice included.*

PRETEST

Must have passed the Level 4 CanSkate Badge. Do not need to have a private coach. A 30 minute group lesson is included. *Off ice included.*

OPEN ICE

This ice is available to all skaters who have 2/3 of Junior Bronze tests or higher. Wed.& Sat. morning open ice is available to T1 skaters or higher.

ADULT SKATE

This program is designed for the proficient adult skater. Wednesday session is for adults who are working towards Skate Canada Tests, or competing. **Off Ice Included on Wed. session only.**

PRESCHOOL CANSKATE (START DATE: WEEK OF OCTOBER 1, 2010)

This fun 30 minute program is for children aged 3-5 years of age.

CANSKATE (START DATE: WEEK OF OCTOBER 1, 2010)

This program is for skaters age 5-10 years of age, who want to learn how to skate or for those skaters who want to improve their basic skating skills. Returning skaters who have passed Stage 4 must register in either PreTest or CanPower.

CANPOWER SKATE (START DATE: WEEK OF OCTOBER 1, 2010)

Skaters must have attained CanSkate Stage 4 OR be proficient at skating forward, backward and stopping. Friday CanPower will resume after Christmas due to Inch Park renovations. Registrations will be available in November for the Friday CanPower program.

*Note – Full hockey equipment including stick is required.

TEENSKATE/ADULT (LEARN TO SKATE) RECREATIONAL (START DATE: WEEK OF OCTOBER 1, 2010)

This is a learn to skate program for skaters age 13 and older.

OFF ICE PROGRAM

Due to the many benefits of this program, off ice is offered for Test 1, Test 2, Test 3, Competitive, as well as Adult & Pretest. All off ice programs are included in your fee structure and all skaters are encouraged to participate in this off ice program for maximum benefit to the skaters.

*****FALL SKATING ONLY- OUT OF CLUB SKATERS *****

Out of club skaters may guest skate on sessions that are not full during September prior to skater's home club winter club start up and prior to Isabelle Henderson Memorial Invitational. Each session will be \$15.00 (guest ticket may be purchased at the office). This does not include off ice. If you choose to participate in off ice please see Brenda at the office for an additional fee.

Out of club skaters may register for the entire winter season and registration forms will be processed after August 21, 2010.

TEST DAYS – Test Chair – Marian Wiskar

Tentative Test Days – October & December 2010 & March 2011. A letter of permission from a skater's home club is required before any guest skater may take a test.

The Skaters Lottery

Membership Fees

The HSC requires **100% of membership fees** with registration. **Cheques to be made out to the Hamilton Skating Club.** Families of three or more children living in the same household are entitled to a 10% discount. A **\$10.00 - Administration Fee** for every session change request or additional tax receipt request.

PreSchool/CanSkate, CanSkate, CanPower, TeenSkate/Adult (Learn to Skate): NO registrations will be processed until payment has been received with forms. Payment schedule (Post dated cheques) – Oct 1/10, Nov 1/10 & Dec 1/10.

All Carnival payments must be made by Jan.1, 2011 by cash or post-dated cheques.

Deposit Information- Pretest and up to and including Competitive Skaters.

A 25% deposit is required for all levels of skaters at the time of registration **1st -25% (dated Sept.1/10)** The balance will be paid by post-dated cheques (**which must accompany the registration form**). **Post-Date 2nd – October 1/10- 25%**
3rd – November 1/10- 25%
4th – February 1/11- 25%

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Applications can be mailed or dropped off at the HSC office. Registration forms must be completed in full. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. Priority will be given to HSC current members until August 21, 2010.

Confirmations will not be given unless problems arise with your choice of sessions.

NSF cheques are subject to a \$40 Administration Fee.

If you have had more than two NSF's, only cash or money order will be accepted with registration.

NO REFUNDS unless with written proof of a medical reason (Doctor's Certificate). No refunds after September 8, 2010 for StarSkate programs and Oct 30 for recreational programs (CanSkate, PreSchool CanSkate, CanPower, TeenSkate).

The Hamilton Skating Club Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel/alter programs/sessions for special events, test days.

No refunds or adjustments will be made due to the loss of ice time on test days or rebalancing of numbers for sessions.

The Hamilton Skating Club Board of Directors reserves the right to change the schedule and cancel sessions due to enrolment.

All outstanding fees and coaching accounts must be paid in full prior to taking a test. No registrations will be accepted if a current account is found to be in arrears (Registration fees/Guest skating fees/Coaching fees).
