ON ICE PROGRAMS OFFERED-

COMPETITIVE

For single skaters who have passed a competitive test or senior silver free skate test. No dance or pairs skating allowed on the competitive free skate session. Off ice included.

TEST 3 (T3)

All skaters must have passed 2 COMPLETE Senior Bronze Dance & Skill Tests OR the complete Sr. Bronze Free Skate or must be 16 years of age or older and have a private coach. Off ice included.

TEST 2 (T2)

All skaters must have passed 2 COMPLETE Preliminary Tests (ie. **ANY 2 OF A COMPLETE** Free Skate, Skills or Dance Test) and have a private coach. Off ice included.

TEST 1 (T1)

All Skaters must have passed Stage 6 of the CanSkate program and can do a Waltz jump, Salchow and Toe Loop, and must have a private coach. Off ice included.

Turns and Loops

Help improve your footwork by working on the technical aspect of turns and loops. Skaters should be working on Junior Bronze skills or higher. This session is taught in a group format.

OPEN ICE

This ice is available Monday-Friday to all skaters who have 2/3 of Junior Bronze tests or higher. Wednesday & Saturday morning open ice is available to T1 skaters or higher.

THE RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS

Using the nationally acclaimed Skate Canada "CanSkate Program" as the foundation, this program offers beginners the opportunity to learn to skate. In addition, we have a post CanSkate program called Pretest (**must have passed their level 4 CanSkate Badge**), CanPowerSkate, TeenSkate & Adult programs are also offered.

PRESCHOOL CANSKATE, CANSKATE, CANPOWERSKATE AND TEENSKATE

PreSchool CanSkate and CanSkate are our learn to skate programs. PreSchool CanSkate is geared to the 3-5 yr. old. CanSkate is a learn to skate program for the 5 yr old and up. CanPowerSkate is designed to incorporate basic skating skills combined with hockey skating skills. TeenSkate is designed for the 11- 16 yr. old providing skating skills for the beginner. Learn to Skate TeenSkate (11yrs and older) will run simultaneously during Saturday CanSkate (12:15-1:00PM).

PRE TEST

Must have passed the Level 4 CanSkate Badge. A group lesson of spins, jumps and edges is included. Off ice included prior to the pretest on ice session. Skaters are not required to have a private coach although a private lesson is encouraged to speed up the skater's progress.

FAST TRACK

The Hamilton Skating Club will offer the Fast Track program. This session is taught in **GROUP format only**. Skaters chosen for this program have met certain requirements, and have been contacted. A signature from a professional coach must be accompanied on your registration form. The main focus of the program is to make a smoother transition into the Skate Canada Star Skate program, which is our T1 session. A short off ice class is included.

*Note – Skaters registered in this program must be 8 years or younger & registered on an additional session (ie. CanSkate or PreTest)

ADULT SKATE

Adult - Tuesday (Learn to Skate Adult). Wednesday evening (Must have skating experience). Off Ice Included Wed. 8:00-9:00PM.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TEST DAYS

Tentative test day scheduled for Sat. June 12. Watch for notices. Out of Club members are reminded to supply a letter of permission from your Home Club in order to test at the Hamilton Skating Club.

MEMBERSHIP

Registration forms must be completed in full. Incomplete forms will not be processed. HSC 2009/10 winter members will be given priority until Mar.5/10. Hallwint region will be processed after Mar.5. Out of region registrations will be processed after March 20, 2010 and are subject to availability. Out of club and out of region skaters must provide proof of eligibility to skate on requested session.

Confirmations WILL NOT be given unless problems arise with your choice of sessions.

PAYMENT TERMS

StarSkate, Test and Competitive Skaters ONLY

A deposit of 50% is required at the time of registration. The balance MUST be included with the registration form, post dated no later than April 20, 2010. All payments are made to the Hamilton Skating Club. A 10% discount (not including Skate Canada fee) can be applied for families with 3 or more skaters living in the same household.

Pre-Test, Fast Track, PreSchool, CanSkate, CanPowerSkate, TeenSkate & Adult must receive FULL payments prior to the start of the season.

Payment must be in FULL at time of registration. All payments are to Hamilton Skating Club. A 10% discount not including Skate Canada for 3 or more skaters living in the same household.

*NOTE: Club credits can be used towards registration or test day fees during Hamilton Skating Club Off Season. All session change requests will be subject to a \$10.00 administration fee.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Applications can be mailed or dropped off at 25 Hester St. L9A 2N3. If dropping off in person please drop in the white mail box located outside the Hamilton Skating Club office.

NSF cheques are subject to a \$40 Administration Fee.

No refunds unless with written proof of a medical reason ONLY.

No refunds after April 20, 2010.

If you have had more than two NSF's, only cash, certified cheque or money order will be accepted with registration.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel/change programs/sessions due to enrolment/special events and test days.

Session fees have already been adjusted for the loss of ice time due to test days and holidays.

All outstanding fees and coaching accounts must be paid in full prior to taking a test

No registrations will be accepted if a current account is found to be in arrears.

GUEST SKATING –Guest skating booklets may be purchased at the office. Booklets are \$75.00 for 5 tickets. Tickets **must be** purchased prior to skating on any session. Tickets are to be handed in at the music booth signed, dated and session to be used for recorded on the back.

CANSKATE/PRESCHOOL, CANPOWERSKATE SKATERS

All skaters must wear CSA approved hockey helmets. Bicycle helmets are not acceptable and not safe enough.
