ON ICE PROGRAMS OFFERED

DAY PROGRAMS

Competitive

For single skaters who have passed a competitive test or senior silver free skate test. No dance teams or pairs skating allowed on the competitive free skate session. Off ice included.

T3

All skaters must have passed 2 COMPLETE Senior Bronze Dance & Skill Tests OR the complete Sr. Bronze FreeSkate or must be 16 years of age or older and have a private coach. Off ice included.

T2

All skaters must have passed 2 COMPLETE Preliminary Tests (ie. **ANY 2 OF A COMPLETE** FreeSkate, Skills or Dance Test) and have a private coach. Off ice included.

T1

All Skaters must have passed Stage 6 of the CanSkate program and can do a Waltz jump, Salchow and Toe Loop, and must have a private coach. Off ice included.

DAY CAMP – Week 3 (JULY 12-16) Week 4 (JULY 20-24) AND Week 5 (JULY 27-30) Week 6 (AUG.3-6)

This program is designed for the T1 and T2 skater who wishes to experience a full day camp program. Skaters will be dropped off at 8:30AM and picked up at 3:30PM. This camp will be an exciting adventure for all who participate including daily crafts, workshops, strategy planning sessions and many more activities. The skater must be registered for the 5 day program to participate in the camp.

The Recreational Program – Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday Evenings

Using the nationally acclaimed Skate Canada “CanSkate Program” as the foundation, this program offers beginners the opportunity to learn to skate. In addition, we have a post CanSkate program called PreTest (**must have passed their Stage 4 CanSkate Badge**), CanPowerSkate, PreSchool CanSkate, Fast Track, TeenSkate and AdultSkate.

PreTest

The main focus of the program is to make a smoother transition into the Skate Canada STARSkate program, which is our T1 session. Must have passed the Stage 4 CanSkate Badge. Off ice included. See Recreational brochure and registration forms for details .

CanSkate/Preschool CanSkate/CanPowerSkate & TeenSkate

CanSkate/Preschool CanSkate - Tuesday 5:45-6:30PM. Thursday Preschool Canskate and CanSkate 6:15-7:00PM, CanPowerSkate Wednesday 6:30-7:15PM. TeenSkate/Learn to Skate Adult Wednesday 7:30-8:15PM. **CanSkate up to Badge 4 ONLY**. See Recreational brochure and registration forms for details .

Edge Development *****NEW****** Monday evenings

This program will be taught in **group format only**. This session will focus on the development of power, turns and overall edge quality. Program taught and developed by Gina Doleman. Monday-(7:15-8:15PM) **NO PRIVATE LESSONS ON THIS SESSION**.

AdultSkate

Adult –Tuesday On-Ice 9:15-10:15PM, **Wednesday(7:30-8:15PM)-Adult Learn to Skate** See Recreational brochure and registration forms for details of the Learn to Skate Program.

OPEN

Monday (6:00-7:00PM) T1 qualifications and up
Monday (8:15-9:15PM) and Wednesday (8:15-9:00PM) – MUST of passed 2 of 3 Junior Bronze tests.

TEST DAYS

Test day schedules are TBD. Watch for notices. Out of Club members are reminded to supply a letter of permission from your Home Club in order to test at the Hamilton Skating Club. **An Out Of Club fee will apply and must be in good standing with Home Club.**

MEMBERSHIP

Registration forms must be completed in full. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. Applications are due on or before June 13, 2010. Out of region (outside of Hallwert) registrations will be processed after June 14, 2010 and are subject to availability. **Out of club skaters must provide proof of eligibility to skate on requested sessions. Registrations will continue to be accepted until sessions are full.**

Confirmations will not be given unless problems arise with your choice of sessions.

PAYMENT TERMS

Test and Competitive Skaters

A deposit of 50% is required at the time of registration dated June 1 or June 15. The balance must be included with the registration form, post dated no later than June 28, 2010. All cheques are made payable to the **HAMILTON SKATING CLUB.**

10% discount off session cost for 3 or more family members (same household).

Pre-Test, Fast Track, CanSkate, PreSchool CanSkate, CanPower, TeenSkate and AdultSkate

Payment must be **paid in full** at the time of registration. All cheques made payable to the **HAMILTON SKATING CLUB.**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Applications can be mailed or dropped off at the HSC office at the Mountain Skating Centre.

NSF cheques are subject to a \$40 Administration Fee.

Refunds or credits must be requested in writing accompanied with a medical certificate.

No refunds after June 28, 2010.

Skate Canada fee is non-refundable.

If you have had more than two NSF's, only cash or money order will be accepted with registration.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel/change programs/sessions due to enrolment/special events and test days.

No refunds or adjustments will be made due to the loss of ice time on test days, holidays or for personal vacations. There will be no make up sessions.

All outstanding fees and coaching accounts must be paid in full prior to taking a test.

No registrations will be accepted if a current account is found to be in arrears.

NOTE*- Skaters registered in HSC Summer DAY programs (a minimum of 8 DAY REGISTERED sessions) qualify for a HSC summer souvenir.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All skaters must register for the program that they currently qualify for at the time of registration. If testing occurs after registered, a skater may move up only if there is room on the higher session.

GUEST SKATING GUEST SKATING BOOKLETS - Must be purchased in advance from the office. **Evening Programs-** A booklet of tickets is \$75.00 for 5 tickets. **Day Programs** is \$20.00 per session or \$45.00 per day (includes 2 sessions plus off ice). No guest skating on full sessions. Maximum of one guest skate per week during the summer. Tickets must be handed in to music person prior to skating the session.

CANSKATE/PRESCHOOL/CANPOWER SKATERS

All skaters are required to wear CSA approved hockey helmets. Bicycle helmets are not acceptable and not safe enough.
