Competitive Skate / STAR 1 to GOLD / Adult Programs

COMPETITIVE SKATE (Minimum registered days = 5)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Competing Pre-Juvenile or higher Director of Skater Development may move skaters at his discretion. Competitive Test or Gold Free Skate
STAR 5 TO GOLD (Minimum registered days = 3)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minimum of 2 COMPLETE Senior Bronze Tests (Any 2 complete Freeskatte, Skills or Dance) Must have minimum of 3 COMPLETE STAR 5 Assessments Skaters competing STAR 5 or higher
STAR 3 - 5 (Minimum registered days = 3)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3 COMPLETE STAR 3 Assessments 3 COMPLETE Preliminary Tests Skaters competing STAR 3 or STAR 4
STAR 1 - 3 (Minimum registered days = 2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Completed CanSkate Stage 5 or 6 Able to do: Waltz jump, Salchow and Toe Loop Skaters competing STAR 1, STAR 2 or STAR 3 Must have a private coach
FAST TRACK By invitation ONLY (Minimum registered days = 2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Skaters must be invited to participate in this program All skaters must be in figure skates MUST be registered for at least one additional session in STAR 1 – 3 or Group STAR 1-3 or Canskate 4 or higher.
ADULT SKATE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Designed for the proficient adult skater (18 or older) and/or for the adult who wishes to compete. Off-Ice is included
Group STAR 1 - 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This session is taught in a group lesson format for skaters that have completed CanSkate Stage 5 or higher. Must be in figure skates
OPEN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No off-ice included. OPEN 3:00 p.m. - ALL 3 Complete Sr. Bronze tests OPEN 9:00 p.m. - complete STAR 4 or higher
STEEL CITY SYNCHRO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Synchro is a discipline involving a team of skaters. The team performs to music while demonstrating edges and flow. Skaters from all area Skate Canada sanctioned clubs are welcome MUST be registered in at least one other STAR Skate session at skater's home club.
TEST DAY	Wed. November 29, 2017 AND Sat. March 24, 2018

GENERAL INFORMATION	<p>Session Qualifications</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All skaters must register for the program that they currently qualify for at the time of registration. If testing occurs after registered, a skater may move up only at the next registration season. <p>Out of Club Skaters</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Out of club skaters are welcome. Proof of eligibility (tests completed) may be requested, to ensure appropriate session is selected. Out of club coaches are welcome (subject to board approval). Before going on the ice, a 'Guest Coach Contract' must be signed. <p>Concerns</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Concerns regarding the operation of the Club can only be addressed effectively by bringing them in writing to the attention of the HSC Board of Directors. <p>GUEST SKATING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> \$30.00 per session, to be paid prior to skating \$45.00 for Sat COMP session, to be paid prior to skating \$5.00 for first 15 (after registered session) or last 15 (before registered session) off-session skating for lesson with coach No guest skating OR off-session skating on full sessions – no exceptions <p>CANSKATE AND TEEN / ADULT SKATERS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All skaters are required to wear CSA approved hockey helmets, until the skater has completed Stage 5. Bicycle helmets are not acceptable. <p>ICE Etiquette & Code of Conduct</p>
MEMBERSHIP	<p>Registration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Registration forms must be completed in full. Registrations will continue to be accepted until sessions are full. Confirmations will not be given unless problems arise with your choice of sessions. Out of club skaters' registrations are subject to board approval. <p>Registration Priority Deadlines:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Registered HSC skaters will have first priority up until Aug 22. Out of Club registrations will be processed after Aug 23, 2017 and are subject to availability. Out of Club skaters must provide proof of eligibility to skate on requested sessions.
PAYMENT TERMS Cash, Debit or cheque made payable to the HAMILTON SKATING CLUB.	<p><u>ALL COMP / STAR & Adult Programs:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A deposit of a minimum of 25% is required at the time of registration. The balance can be paid as installments. Include post dated cheques with registration form or indicate dates that debit or cash will be paid <p><u>ALL Recreation programs:</u> Payment must be paid in full at the time of registration</p>
TERMS AND CONDITIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Applications can be dropped off at the HSC office at the Dave Andreychuck Mountain Arena and Skating Centre. The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel/change programs/sessions due to enrolment/special events and test days. No refunds or adjustments will be made due to the loss of office time on test days, holidays, for personal vacations OR circumstances out of the Hamilton Skating Club's control such as inclement weather, City of Hamilton Arena closures (scheduled or unscheduled), etc... There will be no make up sessions. All outstanding fees and coaching accounts must be paid in full prior to taking a test. No registrations will be accepted if a current account is found to be in arrears. <p>NSF Cheques</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> NSF cheques are subject to a \$40 Administration Fee. If you have had more than two NSF's, only cash or money order will be accepted with registration. <p>Refunds / Credits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Skate Canada Fee is non-refundable Medical refunds or credits must be requested in writing accompanied with a medical certificate. They will then be reviewed by the Board.
