TERMS AND CONDITIONS	Applications can be mailed or dropped off at the HSC office at the Mountain Skating Centre. (Drop off in the club white mail box located outside of HSC club office).  NSF cheques are subject to a \$40 Administration Fee.  Refunds or credits must be requested in writing accompanied with a medical certificate (issued by Medical Doctor).  No refunds after Sept 8, 2012 for StarSkate programs and Oct 30, 2012 for recreational programs (CanSkate, PreSchool CanSkate, CanPower, TeenSkate).  Skate Canada fee is non-refundable and cannot be pro-rated.  If you have had more than two NSF's, only cash or money order will be accepted with registration.  The Board of Directors reserves the right to cancel/change programs/sessions due to enrolment/special events and test days.  No refunds or adjustments will be made due to the loss of ice time on test days, holidays or for personal vacations. There will be no make up sessions.
