SPRING 2011 SESSION

Spring 2011 Brochure and Registration is now available. The Spring Session runs from April 26 to June 17, 2011.

Private lessons will no longer be offered on our CanSkate sessions. The sessions are being expanded to 50 minutes of group instruction. CanSkate is a National Learn to Skate program, based on teaching in a group environment. Skaters are still able to book private lessons with a coach, but this will be offered on PreSchool Icetime. The PreSchool session

will remain the same, but skaters in Private lessons will have access to the Fast Track as well as about 1/4 of the ice surface.

Once skaters have attained Stage 4, they have 2 options. If they are wearing hockey skates, they can move to the Can-PowerSkate session. If the skater is wearing figure skates, then they can move to the PreTest sessions. Both sessions are based on a group instruction.

Private lessons are still available on the PreTest session. It is the parents responsibility to arrange private lessons, directly with the coach of their choice. Phone numbers are all listed on the brochure. SKATERS PICK PAGE 2



A DRESS REHEARSAL—APRIL 8, 2011

Dress Rehearsal is on Friday April 8, 2011. Skaters are to be at the arena for 5:00 pm and must be signed in upon arrival in the lobby. More details will be made available closer to the date.

We will be having Future Stars Photography coming in to do group and individual skater pictures on Dress Rehearsal Day. Photo Packages will be available for purchase. Further information will be made available prior to the dress rehearsal.



Skaters are to be dropped off and registered in the main lobby outside the Hamilton Skating Club office. Only the parent who registers the skater will be permitted to pick them up.

<u>The Audience Entrance is the Hester Street Entrance</u>. Parents must walk around to the Hester Street Entrance to enter the arena for the show after dropping off their skater(s).

PRESCHOOL SKATERS

PreSchool skaters must be accompanied by a parent at all times at the dress rehearsal and show. Once they have skated on the show day, they will join the parents in the stand to watch the remainder of the show. They are not part of the finale.

CANSKATE SKATERS

All CanSkaters will be able to watch the other half of the show they are not in. They will be accompanied by the Dressing Room Volunteers. Children <u>must</u> stay with the group and will not be allowed to join their parents in the stands. CanSkaters are part of the finale.

SNACKS FOR SKATERS

Please send bottled water and snacks with the skaters —preferably nothing that is sticky or staining (due to costumes). It is a long show and the skaters will require drinks and snacks.

Concession Stand / Vending Machine visits are NOT permitted.
