TEST DAYS—Mar 9 & 10, 2011

As a reminder to all, Test Fees are due 48 hours prior to Test Day. Test Fee Schedule is posted on the HSC Bulletin Board. Your coach should have provided you with a "test envelope" indicating the skaters' name, and test(s) to be taken.

The Hospitality Fee <u>must</u> be paid by all skaters.

The Out of Club Fee <u>must</u> be paid by all skaters who are not registered with HSC for the 2010—2011 Fall/Winter season.

SPRING 2011 SESSION

Spring 2011 Brochure and Registration is now available. The Spring Session runs from April 26 to June 17, 2011.



ALL skaters must register ONLY for the program that they qualify for at time of registra-

tion submission. Please check the Spring 2011 Brochure for more details for session qualifications for T1, T2, T3, & Competitive. For Example: Skater must have 2 of 3 complete Preliminary Tests (complete FreeSkate, Dances or Skills) to register for T2. Skaters who wish to

change sessions after test day can only do so if space available. No double booking will be accepted due to skater volume / No Exceptions.

TAX RECEIPTS

Tax Receipts are available through the Skate Canada Website provided you have the skaters Skate Canada number. If you are unable to login to the Members Only page, or you notice any spelling errors, please come into the office so we can make any necessary changes.

- 1. Go to: www.hamiltonskating.org
- 2. Click on the "Links" heading and a drop down box will appear. Click on the "Skate Canada" button.
- 3. Once in the Skate Canada site go to the far right and choose the "Members Only" heading and click on it
- 4. Enter your Login User ID this is the Number on your Skate Canada membership card.
- 5. Enter your password this is your skater's last name
- 6. Click on the "logon" button
- 7. Once you have successfully logged in, you will notice a menu on the side. Click on "Personal Profile" and a drop down box will appear. Choose Child Tax Credit Receipt and click on it.
- 8. A listing of receipts will come up and you can click on "Print" or "Reprint" beside the session you wish to print.

DRESS REHEARSAL—APRIL 8, 2011

Dress Rehearsal is on Friday April 8, 2011. Skaters are to be at the arena for 5:00 pm and must be signed in upon arrival in the lobby. More details will be made available closer to the date.

We will be having Future Stars Photography coming in to do group and individual skater pictures on Dress Rehearsal Day. Photo Packages will be available for purchase. Further information will be made available prior to the dress rehearsal.



Skaters are to be dropped off and registered in the main lobby outside the Hamilton Skating Club office. Only the parent who registers the skater will be permitted to pick them up.

<u>The Audience Entrance is the Hester Street Entrance</u>. Parents must walk around to the Hester Street Entrance to enter the arena for the show after dropping off their skater(s).

PRETEST AND T1 SKATERS

Arrangements have been made for PreTest and T1 skaters on 1 of the 2 show dates to watch the other half of the show they are not in (on the other day—they will be in the dressing room during the other half). They will be accompanied by the Dressing Room Volunteers. Skaters <u>must</u> stay with the group and will not be allowed to join their parents in the stands. PreTest and T1 Skaters are part of the finale.

T2, T3, & Competitive SKATERS

T2, T3, and Competitive Skaters are in both halves of the show, they will not be able to watch the show.

SNACKS FOR SKATERS / NO VALUABLES PLEASE

Please send bottled water and snacks with the skaters —preferably nothing that is sticky or staining (due to costumes). It is a long show and the skaters will require drinks and snacks.
